- Organize and carry out office management related activities within the organization.

Key competencies:

Excellent eye for design: have a flair for creating visually appealing communication material. Experience with a variety of design software, including Photoshop, InDesign etc.

Communicator: experience in developing meaningful multimedia content for your target audience as well as strong communication abilities to interact with colleagues and clients.

Technically strong: ability to create promotional material using graphic design software, record and edit video footage, create and maintain websites (using Mett), create and send out mailings (Mailchimp), and effectively and efficiently deploy social media.
