Step 1:

Step 2:

Regulations

The EFFoST Student of the Year Award is open to registered students of MSc or PhD programmes at European universities in the academic year 2017

– 2018 or MSc students that have completed their degree in the period July 2017 – June 2018.

Students must have been registered in a degree program in food science and technology or similar. Part-time students can also apply.

Popular vote

Nominees will also be in the running for the popular vote prize. Conference delegates will choose the winner based on the students’ poster presentation at the conference. The voting will take place at the 32nd EFFoST International Conference in Nantes.
