To apply

Step 2. Submit the online application form with the relevant documents at www.studentoftheyear.eu.

Complete step 1 and 2 before 31 May 2021.

Regulations

The EFFoST Student of the Year Awards are open to registered students of MSc or PhD programmes at European universities in the academic year 2020 – 2021 or MSc students who completed their degree in the period July 2020 – June 2021. Students must have been enrolled in a degree program in food science and technology or similar. Part-time students can also apply.

Popular vote

The top 15 applicants will be invited to join the Popular Vote competition for the best student poster presentation. The winner will be chosen by the conference delegates at the 35th EFFoST International Conference in Lausanne, Switzerland. Nominees of the other categories cannot compete for the Popular Vote prize.
