Regulations

The EFFoST Student of the Year Awards are open to registered students of MSc or PhD programmes at European universities in the academic year 2023 – 2024 or MSc students who completed their degree in the period July 2023 – June 2024. Students must have been enrolled in a degree program in food science and technology or similar. Parttime students can also apply.

Popular vote

The top 10 applicants will be invited to join the Popular Vote competition for the best student poster presentation. Upon nomination, the applicants will be asked to upload a three minute flash presentation video. This video will be shown as part of the plenary session and will be considered as part of the evaluation. The winner will be chosen by the conference delegates of EFFoST2024.
